Position: Quality and Sustaining Engineer

Mission:

The Quality and Sustaining Engineer is responsible for quality process improvements and Product Improvement through Sustaining Engineering Initiatives.

Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities

- Monitor NCR and Complaint metrics and recommend improvements in products and processes in order to eliminate recurrences.
- Root Cause Analysis of Complaint and NCRs.
- Assist the Quality & Sustaining Engineering Manager in implementing large scale QMS improvement projects.
- Work with Operations in implementing and monitoring shop floor quality data collection and analysis.
- Work with Applications Engineers on resolving customer specific quality issues.
- Work with Operations in documenting and executing validation protocols for new or changed processes and equipment.
- Work with Design Engineers to develop quality characteristics for new products and recommend inspection points.
- Manage the Validation Master Plan under the guidance of the Quality & Sustaining Engineering Manager.
- Perform internal quality audits per the audit schedule.
- Program automated measuring equipment for use of QC Inspectors and CNC operators.
- Other duties as assigned.
